Fantastic news – we are back at The White Rock Theatre for 2024 and the future is secure. From 31<sup>st</sup> January 2024 the theatre will be run by The Guildhall Trust and it sounds very positive.

CEO of The Guildhall Trust, Andy Grays, said: "We are very excited about becoming the new operator for the White Rock. I'd like to thank Hastings Borough Council for entrusting such an important cultural asset to us. We will make both them and the community proud. The venue has tremendous potential, and we aim to explore this potential through programming, community partnerships, schools and creative engagement, and investment in the building. As a charitable trust, we're a values-led organisation which places community and cultural engagement at the heart of everything we do."
